Internships / Work Experience	All students regardless to their Study Programme are given the opportunity to take part in the Internship Programme. Students undertake work experience placements to obtain key employability skills, gain experience in different industry sectors ready for their Post 17 or 18 progression plans. This can include University, College, Apprenticeships or Employment.
